Note to Readers: In the event of any inconsistency between this document and the legislation that affects chiropractic practice, the legislation governs.

Intent

To ensure third-party payors are not billed in excess of the chiropractor's normal fee.

Description of Policy

Registrants may not bill any payor fees in excess of his/her usual normal fee billed to a private patient for similar services. The practice of having one fee for patients and a higher fee for a third-party payor, or various fees for different third-party payors (e.g., dependent upon the amount of coverage) is unacceptable.
